### **Cancer Prevention Europe**

Cancer Prevention Europe launched a multilingual online programme on primary and secondary prevention of cancer, primarily targeted to managers of cancer leagues, cancer prevention advocates, and health promoters. The programme consists of two sets of self-learning modules.

The first set of modules, on the "European Code Against Cancer 4th edition", has a module for each of the 12 recommendations in the Code and an additional module on the methodology followed in developing the Code.

The second set, on the "Latest evidence on cancer prevention, myths and controversies", presents the latest evidence on cancer prevention, published after the launch of the Code in 2014 until today, and tackles some myths and controversies related to the topics addressed by the 12 recommendations of the European Code Against Cancer 4th edition.
